Project Parameters


The following parameters have been determined for the project:









Based on what we heard was important to you, we identified six key priorities that will inform design scenarios as follows:



How to Weight Priorities in Design?

The different ways priorities are weighted can produce very different physical and programmatic design outcomes which means different relationships to the city and its people. While a primary priority is the main driver of the concept, secondary and tertiary priorities inform the details and other aspects of design and programming.

It's important to keep in mind that regardless of the order, all six priorities will be represented in the different design concepts, and the final design. Below is a selection of projects that have similar priorities to the ones identified for Rochester's Aqueduct Project.

Comfort & Climate




Providing protection from the wind, particularly for winter months. Potentially using existing structures and toe path height to our advantage.






Providing some form of protection from rain and snow so as to have parts of the bridge usable throughout the year. This could be achieved by a combination of new and existing structures.






Achieving thermal comfort through the year, including winter. If possible utilizing the utilities like steam pipes that run through the bridge to our advantage for heating.

Sun shade for hot summer months and sun access for winter months.






The Genesee River can be heard well which offers the design opportunity to curate an audio relationship to the river.











Vision for Aqueduct District Streets




